What is Standard Preferred Protection?

Standard Preferred Protection is a powertrain only vehicle service contract program designed for high-mileage vehicles, allowing up to 100,000 miles of additional coverage on vehicles with up to 150,000 miles at the time of sale!

What type of coverage does the program provide?

It provides excellent coverage for the four main component groups: engine, transmission, drive axle assembly and seals and gaskets.

Plus, the program includes roadside assistance and substitute transportation.

What vehicles are eligible?

Most Asian, Domestic and certain European makes and models that are current plus 10 model years old are eligible for coverage. January 1st is the anniversary date for determining model year.

Does the program have any maintenance requirements?

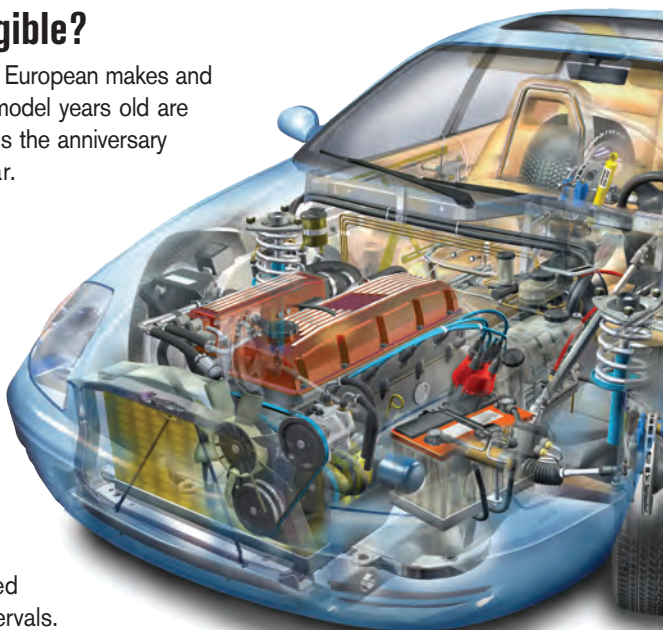
The vehicle must have customary maintenance performed every 6 months or 6,000 miles, whichever comes first. Additionally, all service recommendations outlined by the Manufacturer must be performed at the appropriate service intervals.

What are the limits of liability?

The aggregate limits of liability are as follows:

Standard Preferred Protection

- \$3,000 Engine & Turbo / Supercharger components
- \$2,000 Transmission components
- \$1,500 Drive Axle components



ELIGIBILITY

All vehicles current plus 10 model years old and newer with less than 150,000 miles at time of sale.

Agreements begin on Vehicle Sale Date and mileage is ADD-ON
